INTRODUCTION:

The Center of Latter-day Saint Arts is pleased to announce a program of micro-grants for artists and scholars. Fifty (50) grants of \$250 each will be awarded to scholars, visual artists, writers, composers, designers, choreographers, filmmakers, and other creative artists for works that can be distributed digitally via our website and/or social media platforms in the near future. The project is available to anyone worldwide who self-identifies as part of the Latter-day Saint community.

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS:

Beginning of Opportunity: March 22, 2020

Deadline for Submissions: April 15, 2020

Notification of Adjudication: May 1, 2020

This Call for Submissions is open to scholars and creative artists in any discipline who desire to engage with the goals of the Center to advocate and explore the arts of our culture: visual art, music, literature, film, dance, design, and drama.

We encourage potential applicants to review the kinds of projects already completed by the Center—both to avoid duplication and to understand the scope and rigor of our activities and aspirations—before submitting a proposal. Regarding themes, we welcome any submission that relates to the needs of people at this specific moment in time. We seek works of high artistic or scholarly merit.

PROCESS OF SUBMISSION:

1. Prepare a written proposal of less than 250 words describing your vision of the work, which must be shareable digitally. Each artist or scholar may submit one (1) proposal.
2. It must be original and created specifically for this project, *Art for Uncertain Times*.
3. Include your biographical information, which may note similar previous work or qualifications.

4. Note when you believe the finished work could be completed.
5. Deadline: Completed submissions may be sent immediately and are due no later than April 15, 2020. Send to: glen@centerforlatterdaysaintarts.org with the heading, "Call for Submissions: Art for Uncertain Times".
6. All applicants will be notified of proposal selection results by May 1, 2020.
7. Distribution of grant funds will occur with the completion of the selected works.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. Selected grant recipients will provide work that can be shared digitally.
2. Artists/scholars will keep the original work and retain all copyright of their works.
3. The Call for Submissions is open to all worldwide who self-identify as part of the LDS community. **We seek a diversity of voices.**
